

Divide students into groups of 3. Cut along the dotted lines, fold slips, and distribute one set of words to each group of 3. The slips of paper are distributed randomly among members of a group. Each group member should write down the first word that comes to mind after reading the printed word on each slip of paper. As a small group, share responses; suggest words that other people would have come up with. Discuss how the words reveal stereotypes or underlying assumptions. After 10-15 minutes, reassemble class and talk about how each group's results are the same or different. Discuss how the ideas and stories presented in this book support or challenge our assumptions about certain subjects.
